There will be cash prizes for 1st and 2nd in each section, plus grading prizes if enough entries.

The first prize in the Open section will be at least £60, which will be divided if there is a tie.

The balance of the prize fund is at the discretion of the controllers..

The prize giving will be as soon as practically possible after the last round.
